Gallery Docent

Summary:

Gallery docents take time to learn everything they can about an exhibit—its art and artist(s). They provide guided tours, fun facts, and information to gallery visitors. Docents interact a great deal with gallery visitors act as a representative for the Kayrod Gallery. Docents are needed during regular gallery hours as well as during exhibition opening receptions.

Note: This position may require some weekend and evening work. Notice will be provided in advance, options and arrangements for weekend and evening work.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with facilitation of the Kayrod Gallery events—set up/break down for receptions and other events, greet visitors, stroll to answer questions and provide information
- Lead guided tours and assist participants with navigating gallery exhibitions
- Maintain a knowledge of art prices and assist in the sale of art
- Remind visitors to donate
- Provide information on items of special interests/attention and emphasize safety information
- Serve as greeters in the building, at the Kayrod Gallery Exhibits, and at special events
- Serve as Art Gallery docents to provide guided tours of art exhibits or on field trips
